LANGUAGE ARTS

This week we will be reviewing long vowel sounds (when the vowel says its name such as in *slow* and *read*). We will also review how to turn 2 short sentences into one compound sentence using *and*, *but*, *or*. In grammar, we will talk all about verbs and how important it is to use the noun as a clue as to when to add an *s* to a verb and when not to.

MATH

In math we will begin Topic D by reviewing everything we have learned this year about clocks. We will practice reading and writing the time on both an analog and digital clock to the hour and half hour. Challenge your child at home to find all the clocks in the house and read the time.
