MATH

This Wednesday we will take an assessment on Topics G and H. This assessment will cover how to solve word problems that require subtraction, using a number line to subtract 2 numbers correctly, and matching subtraction problems to their addition fact (example: $7-3=4$ is the opposite of $4+3=7$). We will then begin Topic I by practicing how to subtract with our number racks.
