LANGUAGE ARTS

In language arts this week we will practice reading and writing words that have -ar and -or (such as in orange and art). We will also learn how to replace nouns with pronouns so that instead of saying "The leaf is green" the sentence would say, "It is green". In addition, we will talk about how to add dialogue in our writing.

We will use what we know about groups of tens and ones to quickly figure out more and less (such as understanding that 10 more than 41 is 51, and 1 less than 63 is 62). We will then work on comparing numbers to determine "greater than" and "less than".


